### **OVERVIEW**

This course is designed to fulfill the NIH requirements for training in the Responsible Conduct of Research (RCR), and is coordinated by Postdocs and Early Career Programs (PECP) in the Division of Biology and Medicine at Brown. The Research Integrity Series for Faculty consists of core [\*REQUIRED] and elective modules, with content and discussion topics aimed at more experienced scholars in the biomedical and clinical sciences.

### **REQUIREMENTS**

Faculty must complete a minimum of 8 hours of interactive, \*in-person core and elective content in order to receive RCR certification. Faculty who began training in this course last year and have yet to complete their 8 hours may continue with this year's series. Faculty registered for this course may apply up to 1 hr of in-person external RCR training (for example, a departmental workshop, class, or seminar relating to a topic covered in this class). Attendees must provide PECP with verification of attendance for tracking purposes.

### **FORMAT**

As per the most recent NIH guidance ([NOT-OD-22-055](#)), we may deliver some content by Zoom, but must also include some in-person content. For Zoom sessions, it is required that the level of face-to-face engagement matches that of in-person sessions, which includes use face-to face interactions (cameras on), discussion, active learning, engagement, and interaction among the participants.
